It is my honor to present this Annual Report of the Iowa City Public Library Friends Foundation. I and my fellow board volunteers thank you for your contributions to support our great Library last year.

Thanks to your generosity, the two-year "Better Building, Better Service" campaign surpassed its goal. More than \$255,000 was raised to remodel and reorganize areas of the library. And, more than \$208,000 was received for the Iowa City Public Library to use for whatever is most needed. Those funds came in through the Corporate Partners program, gifts from individuals, and grants from service organizations and other groups, in addition to special events.

You were there with us to enjoy Sushi in the Stacks in September with its behind-thescenes peak at library operations. You were also there to celebrate the milestone anniversary when Prairie Lights Books hosted its 20th Annual Book Gala for Library Friends in November. Your participation ensured tremendous growth of the Arts and Crafts Bazaar in December, and Library Links Golf Classic in June. We appreciate the new friends and partners attracted by these two newer events. Finally, the Book End used bookstore on the second floor of the Library continued its impressive work. A dedicated group of 70 volunteers generated sales of more than \$24,000 while recycling thousands of donated books, music, and movies.

Your gifts provide everyone in our community with the gifts of more to read, listen to, and watch, as well as engaging programs with authors and other interesting people. Those opportunities to learn and enjoy would not be possible without your continued support.



Created in 1986 in honor of Irving Weber to support the Library's local history collection.

James Shive Fund for Books on Tape

Created in 1990 in memory of a noted Iowa City engineer, income is used to purchase audiobooks.

Jessica Lottman Memorial Fund

Created by her parents in 1984 to purchase books for gifted and talented children.

Johnson County Bar Association Fund

Established in 1989 to purchase legal materials for the general reader and support law-based programs.

Linda Severson Memorial Fund

Established in 2011 to purchase mystery books in memory of former long-time Johnson County employee.

Lolly Eggers Fund for Staff Development

Established in 1994 to honor the retiring Library Director with a fund to increase the Library budget for staff training.

McDonald's Children's Listening and Family Literacy Fund

Created in 1990 to meet the musical and literacy needs of children.


Suzanne Richerson Memorial Fund


