Minutes of the Regular Meeting April 25, 2019

DRAFT

Call Meeting to Order. President Paetzold called the meeting to order at 5:07 pm.

Public Discussion. Byers said that AFSCME has been talking with the City about hourly employees. She met with the City Manager, Assistant City Manager, and Human Resources Administrator on April 10. This is an ongoing conversation with City administration. City Council focused on exploring options with hourly positions, including converting these positions into permanent positions. This would potentially affect approximately 300 people. City staff are gathering data from certain divisions in the City about hourly staff and their job functions. Semel asked if hourly staff receive benefits; Byers said they receive IPERS.

Approval of Minutes.

The minutes of the March 25, 2019 Regular Meeting of the Library Board of Trustees were reviewed. A motion to approve the Regular Minutes was made by Freeman and seconded by Washington. Motion carried 9/0.

Items for Discussion/Action.

Policy Review: 801: Circulation and Library Card Policy. Logsden gave a presentation on the Equity Toolkit, which directly speaks to this policy. Carman said there is widespread approval in the community for going fine free for children's and YA materials based on community comments. Semel asked about expected positive impact. Carman said people who would have been blocked from coming to the library will be back. We know that access to books and materials has a positive lifelong effect. Carman said sometimes when a card is blocked it isn't even the child's fines. Such a situation can cause negative interaction with staff who have to say no to a checkout at the point of contact. Kirsch asked if we anticipate moving to fine free for all library materials; Carman said he thinks we will learn a lot from this first step and he hopes so. Kirsch reiterated that the fine is connected to the material, not the user. Beary asked about the case-by-case basis language. Carman said we want to make sure we don't observe patterns of abuse. Beasley asked about the replacement fee and if the child would be blocked from checking out materials if there is a lost book. Semel asked how effective we are at collecting on our bills. Logsden responded that we refer bills to a collection agency after we have exhausted all other possibilities to get materials returned. If a patron finds a book after it has been paid for, the patron may get their money back or receive a credit toward future fines/replacement fees. The collection agency does not report patrons to credit bureaus said Carman.

Beasley willing to support this for a year. A motion to approve the Circulation and Library Card Policy as revised by staff to be reviewed in July, 2020, was made by Semel and seconded by Washington. Motion carried 9/0.

Policy Review: 817: Alcohol in the Library. Washington asked if we have had any trouble with alcohol. A motion to approve the Alcohol in the Library Policy as revised by staff was made by Semel and seconded by Kirsch. Motion carried 9/0.

Election of Officers. The Nominating Committee met a couple of times and presented the following slate: Wes Beary, President, Carol Kirsch, Vice-President, John Beasley Secretary. A motion was made by Washington and seconded by Forkenbrock to accept the slate of officers as presented by the Nominating Committee. Motion carried 9/0.

Staff Reports.

Director's Report. Carman attended his first IUPLA meeting in Des Moines last month. Participants discussed challenges and shared experiences. Carman presented at the City Manager's Roundtable this month. He talked about going fine free for children and YA materials and our SRP materials in six languages. Carman met with Librarian team this month to talk about current issues and hopes for the future. Library Assistants will have a group meeting soon. Carman also presented at Human Rights Commission this month and was able to address the Library's Equity Toolkit initiatives. He felt it was reassuring to hear the Commission's questions. The Volunteer Appreciation event took place last evening and everyone seemed to have a good time. Coordinators are working on the current strategic plan at the department level. The group is thinking about the pre-planning process for our next longer range plan.

Departmental Reports:

Children's Services. Paetzold appreciated the extra materials about the Kids Matter conference staff attended.

Collection Services. Mangano said rights management of ematerials is more challenging than it seems.

IT. Forkenbrock asked about the coordination of the student library card project. Pilkington said the 2nd grade class in Davenport is doing this but we would be the first library in Iowa to do so. We've modeled ours on Los Angeles, North Carolina, Nashville. Paetzold asked about connecting this with the county ID card.

Development Office. McCarthy thanked everyone who has made a donation or signed up for the Looking Forward event. In response to a question from Paetzold, McCarthy said response to the event is less than last year's numbers. Paetzold asked if there is a breakeven point and McCarthy believes this should be fine. The "Eat out to Read" fundraiser continues on May 1 at Goosetown Cafe all day. Paetzold noted that North Liberty is charging a fee to attend author readings in their library and asked if this is customary.

Spotlight on the Collection. Clark said Weber Days begins May 1.

Miscellaneous. No comments.

President's Report. Paetzold thanked Kirsch for filling in last month. She thought the fundraising event last evening was lovely.

Announcements from Members. The Bylaws Committee met and identified four areas for discussion: Does the board have ultimate decision power for making committees; search committee for a director and its makeup; nomination of officers, do we need a dedicated committee or have members suggest some

names instead of having a dedicated committee for this; term for a board member is 6 years; other city boards and commission have three year terms. Paetzold asked if there will be a report on this next month. Semel said the committee didn't have any recommendations but have had discussion. Beary asked for an outline of these particular discussion points. This will be an agenda item next month.

Committee Reports.

Foundation Members. No meeting.

Communications. None.

Disbursements.

The MasterCard expenditures for March, 2019 were reviewed. A motion to approve the disbursements for March, 2019 was made by Kirsch and seconded by Forkenbrock. Motion carried 9/0.

Quarterly Financial Reports. No comments.

Quarterly Use Reports. Mangano said circulation is up as is digital magazine use. She also stated we count streaming items, but not Kanopy.

Set Agenda Order for May Meeting. Bylaws.

Adjournment. A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Forkenbrock and seconded by Kirsch. Motion carried 9/0. President Paetzold closed the meeting at 6:20 pm.

IOWA CITY PUBLIC LIBRARY Board of Trustees

101 BYLAWS

ARTICLE I: NAME AND PURPOSE

ARTICLE II: POWERS AND DUTIES

Section 1. This organization shall be known as the lowa City Public Library Board of Trustees and shall operate a free public library for the City of lowa City.

Section 1. The Board of Trustees shall have the powers and duties set forth in Title 11 of the lowa City Code and as required by Chapter 392.5 of the Code of lowa (13).

Section 2. The powers, duties and procedures shall be subject to all changes or repeals of state law and all such changes or repeals shall take precedence over these bylaws.

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Terms and Qualifications. The Board of Trustees shall consist of nine (9) members, appointed for six (6) year terms by the Mayor of lowa City and approved by the City Council. All members shall be residents of the City and shall be over the age of eighteen (18), except there may be one (1) non-resident member if the library is receiving funds for a county-wide library service on a contract basis. Appointments are approved by the City Council except the non-resident member who is approved by the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2. <u>Compensation</u>. Members shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for expenses incurred relating to official Library business.

Section 3. Vacancies. Any vacancy on the Board because of death, resignation, long-term illness, disqualification or removal due to four (4) consecutive unexcused absences from regular meetings shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, with approval of the City Council, or the Board of Supervisors in the case of the non-resident member. The appointed trustee shall fill out the unexpired term for which the appointment is made. Members are expected to give the Mayor at least 30 days written notice of intention to resign.

Section 4. Orientation for New Members. Prior to the first regular meeting following their appointment, new members shall be provided with copies of these bylaws, pertinent sections of the City Code and other documents that would be useful to Board members in carrying out their duties. They will also be given an orientation briefing by the President of the Board and the Library Director or their designees.

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS

Section 1. <u>Number</u>. The officers of this Board shall be President, Vice-President and Secretary.

Section 2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. The officers shall be elected annually at the April meeting and

shall serve for one year beginning July 1. In February the President shall appoint a nominating committee who will present a slate of officers at the April meeting. Other nominations may be presented from the floor.

- Section 3. <u>Vacancies</u>. In the event of the death or resignation of any officers, the Board shall choose a successor at the first meeting following the vacancy and that person shall hold office until the next regular election of officers.
- Section 4. President. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board, appoint committees, make appointments to the Friends Foundation Board, call special meetings, execute all documents authorized by the Board and generally perform all duties associated with the office. The President and the Secretary shall sign all disbursement lists prepared by the Director.
- Section 5. <u>Vice President</u>. In the event of the absence or disability of the President, or of a vacancy in the Presidency, the Vice President shall assume and perform the duties and functions of the President.
- Section 6. Secretary. The Secretary and the President shall sign all disbursement lists prepared by the Director. In the event of the absence or disability of the President- or the Vice President, the Secretary shall assume and perform the duties and functions of the President.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

- Section 1. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board shall be held at the Library at 5:00 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of the month, January through October. In November and December the meeting shall be held on the third Thursday of the month at the same place and same time. Any change in the regular meeting time or date shall be approved by the Board at a previous regular meeting.
- Section 2. Special Meetings. A special meeting of the Board may be called at any time by the President or at the request of any two Board members for the transaction of business as stated in the call for the meeting. Such requests shall be given to the Library Director who shall give notice as described in Section 3.
- Section 3. Notice of Meetings. Notice of regular meetings shall not be required; a special meeting may be called upon written notice. Notice must be received not less than twenty-four (24) hours before the meeting except for emergencies and must include time, place, date and tentative agenda. News agencies will receive notice via the City's web site.
- Section 4. <u>Place of Meetings</u>. Regular meetings shall be in a place accessible to persons with disabilities.
- Section 5. Quorum. A quorum for the transaction of business at any meeting shall consist of five (5) members of the Board present.
- Section 6. <u>Procedural Rules.</u> Proceedings of all meetings shall be governed by <u>Robert's Rules of Order</u>, most recent edition.

ARTICLE VI: ORGANIZATION OF BOARD BUSINESS

- Section 1. Agendas. The President and the Director shall prepare the agenda for all regular Board meetings. Agendas shall be posted and sent to Board members and the media at least three (3) days prior to the regular meeting. Agendas of <u>all</u> meetings must be posted at least twenty-four (24) hours in advance of the meeting on the bulletin board in the Library lobby and on the Library and City of lowa City websites, as requested by the City Clerk.
- Section 2. Order of Business. The order of business of each meeting shall be established by the Board by motion made from time-to-time as the Board deems necessary. The agenda shall be established and posted in advance of each meeting in accordance with the requirements of the lowa Open Meetings Law (lowa Code Ch. 21).
- Section 3. Minutes. Minutes of all regular and special meetings are to be prepared and distributed to Board members and the City Council. The Library shall keep as a permanent record copies of all minutes, including documents attached to the minutes by Board action.
- Section 4. <u>Board Policies</u>. All policy statements adopted by the Board shall be filed by subject in a policy notebook containing these bylaws. Each policy and each revision shall carry the date of its adoption. Board policies are also available on the library website.
- Section 5. Committee. Board committees and their composition, duties and terms shall be designated by the President. All committees shall make progress reports at each regular Board meeting.

ARTICLE VII: LIBRARY DIRECTOR AND STAFF

The Board shall appoint a qualified Library Director who shall be the executive and administrative officer of the library on behalf of the Board and under its review and direction. The Library Director shall carry out policies adopted by the Board and shall be held responsible for: employment and direction of staff; the care and maintenance of the building and equipment; the efficiency and effectiveness of the Library's service to the public; the provision of library collections and the operation of the Library under the financial conditions set forth in the annual budget. The Director or designee shall attend all Library Board meetings and shall present a report at each regular meeting.

ARTICLE IX: RELATIONSHIP TO Iowa City Public Library FRIENDS FOUNDATION

- Section 1. Membership. The membership of the lowa City Public Library Friends Foundation, a 501(c) 3 nonprofit corporation, consists solely of the Trustees of the lowa City Public Library. Each member of the Board of Trustees shall become a Member of the Friends Foundation Corporation concurrently with becoming a member of the Board of Trustees and shall continue to be a Member of the Friends Foundation Corporation as long as he/she is a Trustee of the Library. Powers and duties of the Members are found in the bylaws of the lowa City Public Library Friends Foundation.
- Section 2. Friends Foundation Board of Directors. The President shall appoint two (2) trustees to serve one-year terms on the Board of Directors of the Iowa City Public Library Friends

Foundation. The terms begin upon the adjournment of the Annual Meeting of Members of the Iowa City Public Library Friends Foundation. The President of the Trustees may serve as a Director. No Trustee may serve more than six (6) consecutive terms as a Director of the Friends Foundation.

ARTICLE X: AMENDMENTS

Section 1.

These bylaws may be altered or repealed, and new bylaws adopted by the members of the Board at any regular meeting or at any special meeting called for that purpose. The proposed changes in the bylaws shall be submitted in writing to the members of the Board at least ten (10) days prior to the meeting for their consideration.

Weber Days –A celebration of Local History

May is National Historic Preservation Month and ICPL's Weber Days. Weber Days in so named to honor Irving Weber, a citizen historian. Weber wrote more than 800 articles for the lowa City Press Citizen, telling the story of life in lowa City. Weber was a third generation lowa Citian, with roots reaching back to the founding of lowa City. Irving Weber was born in 1900 and died in 1997. He was named lowa City's Official Historian in 1989.

Weber Day celebrates local history through programming, workshops, classes, displays, newspaper columns, social media and hearing the stories of those who attend our programs. We partner with other institutions, organizations and members of the community who have a strong interest in local history and who also want to share the story of the lowa City area's past. In May we host



our second Genealogy Lock-In. Using the Digital Media Lab attendees learn about genealogical research from, Theresa Liewer, a guest speaker from the State Genealogical Society. A bonus for researchers is that they are able to stay in the library after closing. Genealogical research is a strong component not only of Weber Days but for staff at the Info Desk staff. We also offer three genealogical workshops highlighting the use of our online resources.

This May we present four Weber on Wednesday (WOW) programs. Two of the programs are related to the history of beer in lowa City. Glenn Erhstein, UI Professor of German, shares the fascinating story of the beer riots of 1884; including the history of prohibition in lowa and the relationship among the various ethnicities that settled in lowa City and the religious make-up of the community. The second beer program is a thorough history of beer brewing in lowa City presented by Doug Alberhasky, the owner of John's Grocery. The two programs together presented a fascinating look at the role of beer in 19th century lowa City. Our third WOW program was not about beer, but held at the Big Grove Brewery as their May History of the Grove event. Melody Dworak and Maeve Clark presented a program about urban renewal and the creation of the Pedestrian Mall, drawing on images from our Digital History Project, shared photos from earlier Weber Days presentations, research from online newspaper resources, invaluable storage items, and newspaper clippings held by the library. A display on the first floor also shares the story of urban development in lowa City.

Our final WOW program focuses on Johnson County. Franklin L. Yoder will share from his new book All in One Room: A History of Country Schools in Johnson County. The Johnson County Historical society published the book and is a co-sponsor of the program. The Children's Department also offers a number of programs and activities related to lowa City area history. Irving Weber would be glad, we think, that the library continues the tradition of sharing the history of lowa City to all ages.



Literary Kiosk

Last winter ICPL hosted a Literary Kiosk from University of lowa Libraries that traveled between local public libraries. Afterwards, we gave feedback saying we would appreciate hosting again or having a dedicated Kiosk. We are happy to report we were selected to receive a dedicated Kiosk that should arrive in the next week or two. We are currently working with UI Libraries staff to select content for the Kiosk. We are delighted to have this in time for summer!

Ready for Summer

Staff at the Help Desk and Bookmobile recently completed the annual "Ready for Summer" training where we review procedures and prepare for the increase in services provided during the summer months. We're currently preregistering students for SRP at all elementary school stops.

Equity Toolkit Update

In April, the group working on the City of Iowa City's Equity Toolkit initiative to explore how racially diverse people get information about the Library finished up the first phase of their work. We identified eight opportunities for action:

Laundromania Outreach Update from Heidi Kuchta, Outreach Assistant

Since the beginning of March, I have been posting a current copy of ICPL's Adult and Children's Event Calendars as well as the current Bookmobile schedule on both lowa City Laundromania location's public bulletin boards.

I delivered about ten books to each location twice — mostly kid's books, but also popular adult fiction paperbacks. In April, when I returned, all the books were gone. When I put out fresh book donations at the Walden Square Laundromania, a girl was waiting for her mom to finish their laundry. I showed her the kid's books and she was immediately interested. She asked if the books were free, and I reassured her they were. She opened a copy of Diary of a Wimpy Kid and was smiling and reading to herself as I left.

They serve members of our community who speak Swahili, French and Spanish and offer a free lunch and snack program in the summer for children. We also added a stop at the Pheasant Ridge Neighborhood Center.
Translate the webpage.	Staff plan to request funds in the FY21 budget for translating the webpage.
More translated information about the Library is needed in print and online.	How to Get a Library Card and Library Card Application translations are now available on the Library's Webpage at www.icpl.org/about/cards . SRP game cards were translated into Spanish, Arabic, French, Swahili and Chinese. We translated information into Swahili and Chinese for the first time.

Looking Forward: Heartland Success

The two presenters graciously responded to several questions from the engaged audience members who also were able to purchase signed books thanks to Prairie Lights Books. Golden Circle supporters then enjoyed conversation and a catered reception on the Englert stage to cap a very special evening for the library. Thank you for your support!

The lowa City Public Library is always full of cookbooks to check out, but I think that spring and summer are probably the most popular times to try out new recipes. Between the varieties of foods coming in from local farms, the rising temperatures that beckon for some cool fare, and the siren-call of the grill, now might be the time for you to come browse some new books and add some new dishes to your repertoire!

With the Farmer's Market coming into full swing, it would be a mistake to not check out some books that will tell you what to do with all that wonderful produce. Look for titles like "Vegetables Illustrated: an Inspiring Guide with 700+ Kitchen-Tested Recipes" by American's Test Kitchen; "Ruffage: a Practical Guide to Vegetables" by Abra Berens; or "The Nimble Cook: New Strategies for Great Meals that Make the Most of Your Ingredients" by Ronna Welsh. Similarly, there are some great new cookbooks right now that focus on heritage recipes and cooking with seasonal, local foods. Check out titles like the updated classic "In Pursuit of Flavor" by Edna Lewis; "A Taste of History Cookbook: the Flavors, Places, and People that Shaped American Cuisine" by Walter Staib; "The Prairie Homestead Cookbook: Simple Recipes for Heritage Cooking in Any Kitchen" by Jill Winger; and Lauren McDuffie's "Smoke, Roots, Mountain, Harvest."

If the heat has you looking for lighter flavors and meals, you might be interested in "Mostly Plants: 101 Delicious Flexitarian Recipes from the Pollan Family;" "ScandiKitchen Summer: Simply Delicious Food for Lighter, Warmer Days" by Bronte Aurell; "Bazaar: Fresh, Flavorful & Deeply Satisfying Vegetarian Recipes for Every Occasion" by Sabrina Ghayour; or "Love & Lemons Every Day: More than 100 Bright, Plant-Forward Recipes for Every Meal" by Jeanine Donofrio. But maybe, when it gets hot out, you just want more heat—the grill. We've got you covered there, too. Check out "Food52 Any Night Grilling: 60 Ways to Fire Up Dinner" by Paula Disbrowe; "Project Fire: Cutting-Edge Techniques and Sizzling Recipes" by Steven Raichlen, or Martha Stewart's "Grilling: 125+ Recipes for Gatherings Large and Small." Maybe you're thinking of taking it a step further and heading for the outdoors and a campfire? Look for "The Skillful Forager: Essential Techniques for Responsible Foraging and Making the Most of Your Wild Edibles" by Leda Meredith and "Campfire Cookbook: 80 Imaginative Recipes for Cooking Outdoors" by Viola Lex.

And don't forget to round out your summer meals! If you've got a sweet tooth, Dan Whalen's "S'mores: 50 Recipes for Gooey, Melty, Crunchy Riffs of the Campfire Classic" will hit the spot! I'll also say that summer can be a delightful time for trying a new beverage—try out something from Maggie Hoffman's "Batch Cocktails: Make-Ahead Pitcher Drinks for Every Occasion" or Lottie Muir's "Wild Mocktails and Healthy Cocktails: Home-Grown and Foraged Low-Sugar Recipes from the Midnight Apothecary."

Whatever your summer menu calls for, we've got you covered at ICPL!

Spring has finally come to Iowa City and with it a plethora of new children's books! Let's take a look at some of my recent favorites.

April Pulley Sayre's "Bloom Boom!" is a photographic celebration of flowers. The large square book size, short rhyming text, and full-bleed photos make this great for sharing in large group and one on one settings. Sayre sets up the titular repeated phrase with photographic collages showing flowers in growth stages. As we turn the page the blooms boom into full spread photos featuring fields, forests, branches, and beds of flowers. Finally, in signature Sayre style, she wraps up the book with informational backmatter about all of the featured flowers making this a great repeat read.

"Hands Up" by Brenna J. McDaniel and illustrated by Shane W. Evans is timely and beautiful. The author's note explains that this work was written in response to the negative connotations many associate with the phrase "hands up". McDaniel uses this text to explore how we put our hands up every day: to greet the sun, to be picked in class, in joy, to get dressed, to play with each other and finally, in protest. The illustrations soar, utilizing bright tones and consistently drawing the eye in an upward motion, there is a warmth here that serves as a constant reminder of the text's message.

While this next title is not new per se, it is new to the Iowa City Public Library. First published in 2016 and issued in the US in 2018 Hui Yuan Chang's "A Pandemonium of Parrots" is part seek and find, part exploration of animal collective nouns, and part poetry. Each full page illustration features a group of animals of the same type, their collective noun, a short poem about said creature and question prompts for specific individuals in each illustration. The penultimate spread features a secondary book-wide seek and find and finally there is a section with a little information about each animal featured. Because each spread is self-contained, this is a really easy book to pick up and put down with younger readers, observant youngsters will also have fun playing 'I spy' with each spread as well.

"The Little Red Stroller" by Joshua Furst and illustrated by Katy Wu, is a lovely look at passing things on as we grow and the community created in doing so. We follow a little red stroller as it is utilized by ten different children and their families. Each family uses and loves the stroller, taking it many places before passing it on to a new family with a younger child. Finally, after many years of use, the little red stroller breaks down, quickly to be replaced by another hand-me-down. Not only is this a lovely story about building community through kindness and sharing, but it features an incredible array of diverse families from multiple backgrounds and with many makeups. A truly delightful read!

Reach for these and other fabulous children's titles at the Library!

Literary kiosk concludes introductory tour, more to arrive

With more than 5,000 stories distributed during a test-run tour in area libraries, "short story machines" are predicted to be a hit in the fall.

From the Iowa City Public Library to the Marion Public Library, a literary kiosk has made monthly stops in Iowa City and area libraries as part of its "Creative Corridor" tour. It will make its final stop in May at the Eastern Iowa Airport.

As part of a trial period before the official, permanent implementation of more "short story machines" this spring, the literary kiosk has been delighting library-goers by dispensing one-, three-, and five-minute stories on receipt-like slips of paper, said Amy Chen, English & American literature librarian at the University of Iowa Main Library.

Right now, the UI Libraries/UNESCO City of Literature has one three-button kiosk that has made stops at the Iowa City Public Library, Coralville Public Library, North Liberty Library, Cedar Rapids Public Library on 5th Avenue, and Marion Public Library. Chen said four more are on the way and are expected to arrive next week.

The original test kiosk, supplied by the French company Short Edition, concluded its tour at Eastern lowa Airport at the beginning of this month.

In an August 2018 press release, lowa City announced its plan to begin testing the new kiosks in hopes of bringing in more in the spring.

"Designed to be quick, easy, and engaging, the Literary Kiosk encourages on-the-spot reading and literacy," the press release said. "The kiosk also increases access to literary content while raising the visibility of literature and highlighting the diversity of writers' voices in our community."

During its tour, community members visiting their local libraries could interact with the kiosk during specific months. In March, both of the public libraries in Cedar Rapids each had the machine for two weeks, creating an opportunity for the community and staff to experiment with all the machine had to offer.

"It was really, really cool," said Amber McNamara, communications-relations manager for both Cedar Rapids public libraries. "It's such a unique experience for people, and our staff had a lot of fun playing with it, testing it out, and then sharing it with patrons. We got a really positive response."

The library is in the process of ordering four more machines that will only have two buttons that are not labeled by reading length, Chen said. Instead, the machines will be left unlabeled so the libraries can change the content according to theme.

"We'll need 100 to 150 stories for each time that we refresh the content, but at first, we just want a wide variety of voices," she said.

While decisions are still being made as to where to place the additional machines, Chen said lowa City is likely to have one at the Main Library, the lowa City Public Library, and at the UI Hospitals & Clinics.

The library also hopes to stock all kiosks with content from local writers. Submissions are now open for the community to submit short pieces of writing for the machines and can be accessed through the UI Libraries webpage, Chen said.

"Faculty, staff, students, even folks that are unaffiliated with the University of Iowa should feel free to submit their writing," she said.

Volunteer turns love of books into more than 1,000 hours giving back to library

IOWA CITY, Iowa (KCRG) - An Iowa City woman has spent nearly a decade volunteering as a way to give back to a place that gave her family so much in return.

For people that may have returned something through the slots at the entrance of the lowa City Public Library, there is a pretty good chance it has fallen right in front of Roberta Holstein- possibly after she has already picked up a handful.

"I'm a reader, so I thought this was a way of giving back," Holstein said of her volunteering.

Holstein will load up the cart, wheel it down the hall, and prepare to put the books back on the shelves. She has been volunteering at the library for nearly ten years, but lately this has been her assignment when she is "on the clock."



"Whatever my contribution is, it's going back into the library into buying more books," Holstein said.

"Our volunteers do approximately the work of about three full time people- a bit more than three full time people," Byers said. "And they check in all of our print material."

But if the recognition from staff members did not prove sufficient, check the wall as you walk into the library; Holstein is a part of a very exclusive group of volunteers.

"There's a plaque out there, you'll see many, many names," Byers said.

The plaque honors volunteers who have spent at least 500 hours at the library helping out- Holstein hit her 1,000 hour mark in 2015.

"It's something that is very, very appreciated by all of us here at the ICPL," Byers said. "Because it just shows the commitment of people to the library here in town."

Holstein said that commitment was an easy choice to make.

"I'm helping the library and I'm helping myself and I'm enjoying it," Holstein said. "It's something that- I don't dread coming to the library every week, I look forward to it."

For those who stop by the library andsee something that is recently returned on the shelves, chances are Holstein put it on the cart to get it there.

IOWA CITY, Iowa (KCRG) - The Iowa City Public Library's Board approved to eliminate the fines on children's and young adult materials starting June 1.

Staff says this will serve as an effort for students to avoid the "summer slide," or students losing knowledge during summer vacation.

The timing of the new regulations is in hopes of encouraging kids and teenagers to read more during summer vacation- and for parents to spend the summer reading to their children, too.

Library staff says after seeing success in other libraries going fine-free, it only made sense for them to set up a similar plan in lowa City. Kara Logsden, the Community and Access Services Coordinator for the library said they are hoping that will translate to an increased interest in the library.

"[Other libraries are seeing] more people are coming in the building, more cards are issued and circulation is actually going up," Logsden said. "So we think that this is a wonderful step forward in removing barriers to access the library."

The new rules apply to any children's or young adult materials, so adults can also check them out fine-free for their kids, too.
