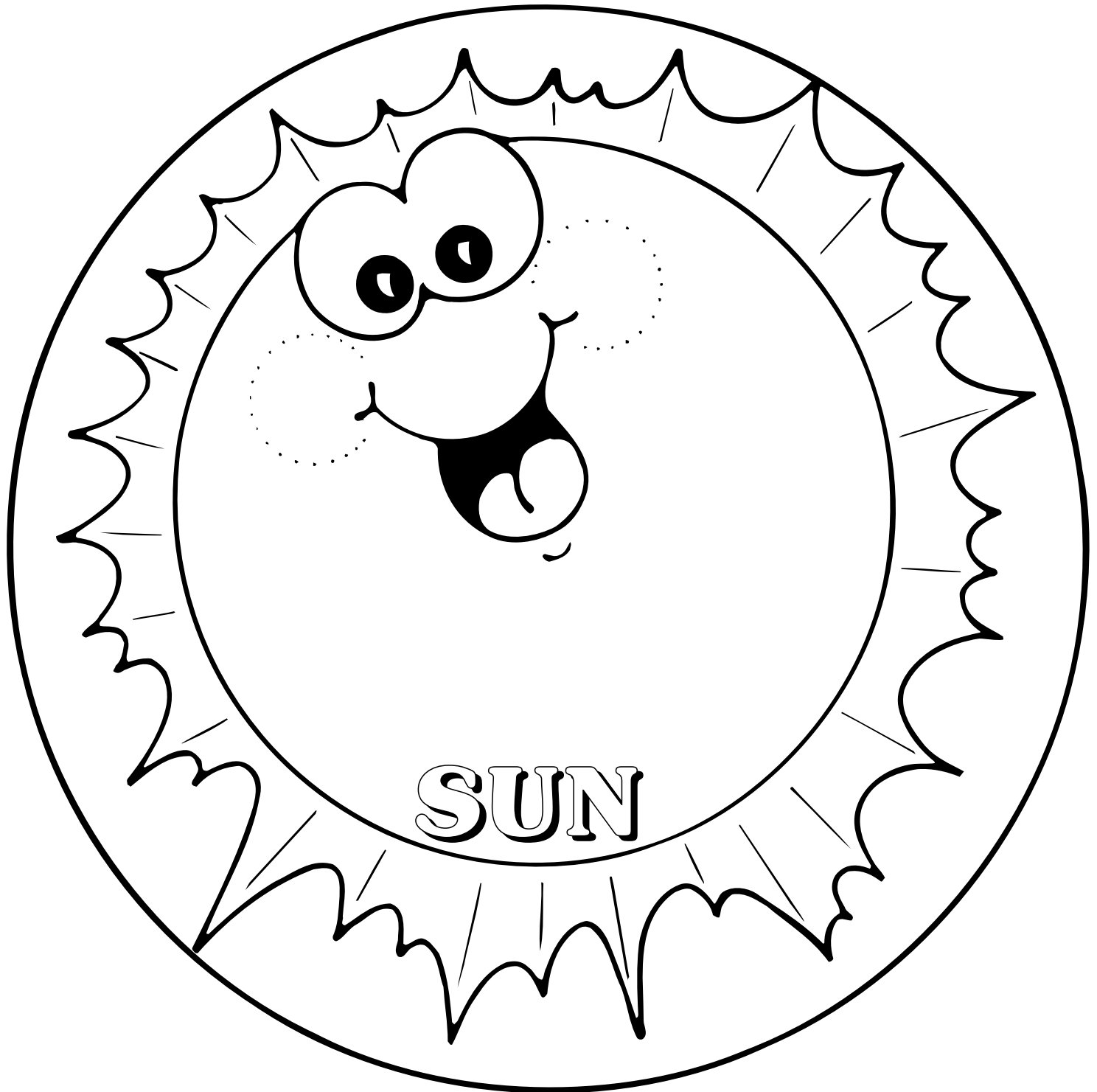
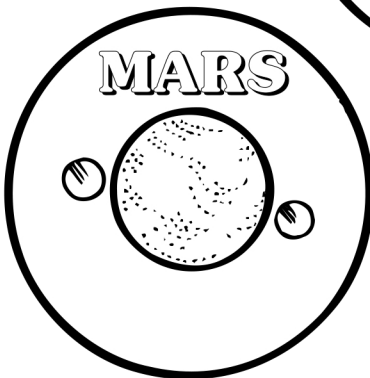
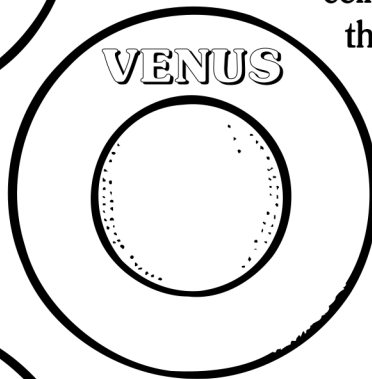
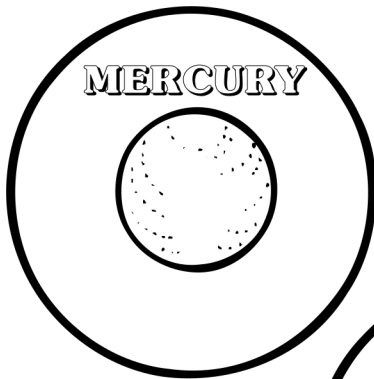
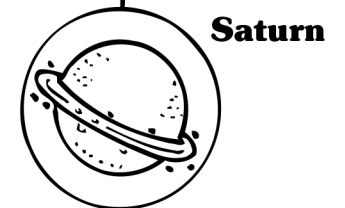
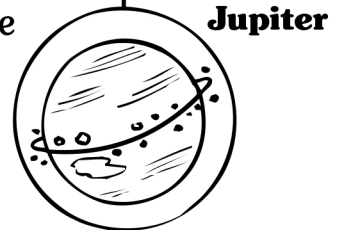
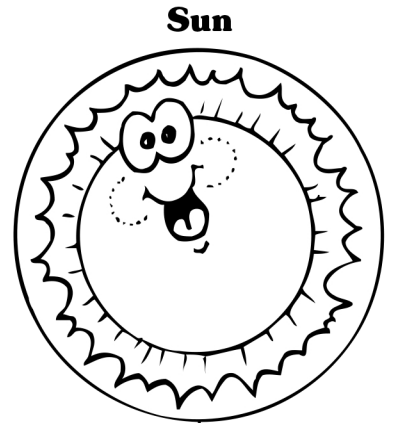
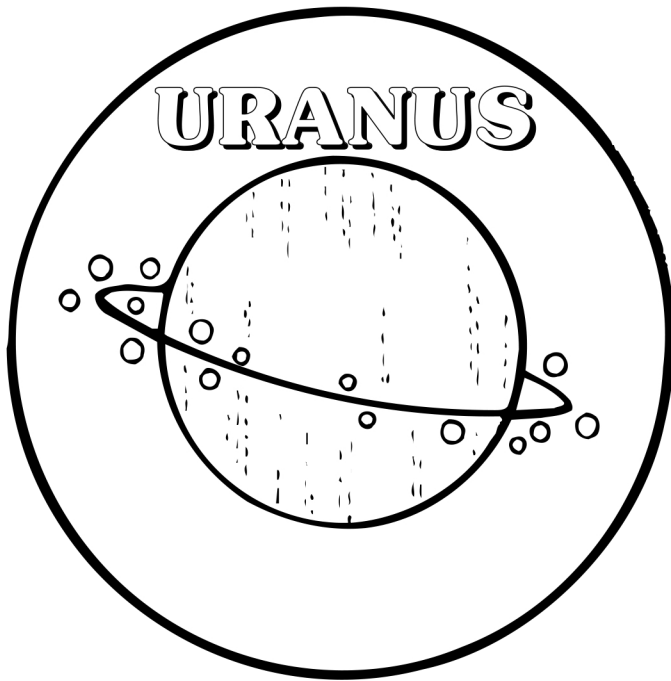


Solar System Mobile

You can make a variety of mobiles with these planet patterns. Each child might wish to make their own, or you could simply arrange the planets on the class bulletin board.





Make two copies of each planet and sun pattern and color with crayons. Cut out each pattern piece. Glue each planet (back to back) down a long piece of string or yarn. Position the planets, in the order of their orbit, around the sun. Hang the mobile from the class ceiling, or have each child make their own mobile and hang it in their room at home.

This planet mobile can also be arranged horizontally. Attach the planets along a piece of yarn, as described above. The display will reach from one side of your classroom to the other if you space the planets apart according to scale.
