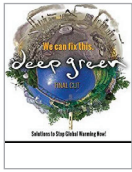

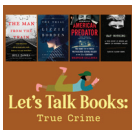

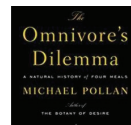
We will discuss the Ken Burns movie Jackie Robinson and the African American sports experience through the decades. A panel of athletes from the University of Iowa will share their experiences.

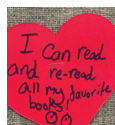

Monday, February 15- Friday, February 19, 10:30-11am daily

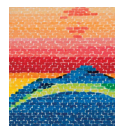
In honor of Black History Month, this week our storytimes will focus on African American achievements, perseverance, courage and talent!
