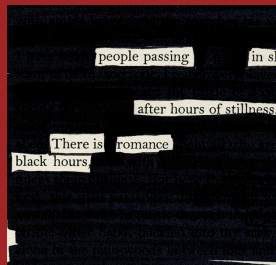


### BLACKOUT POETRY NIGHT

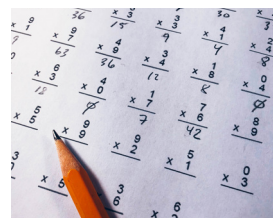
