Think you got game? Bring it to our Saturday Tournaments. All participants will be guaranteed game time and the monthly winner will be awarded a small prize.



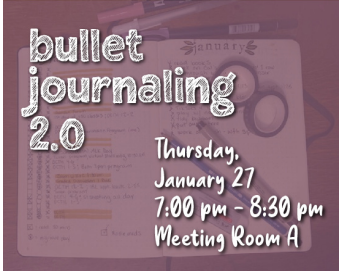
