Join us over in the Ped Mall gardens as we complete planting our salsa and pizza gardens. No experience is necessary and all age groups are welcome!



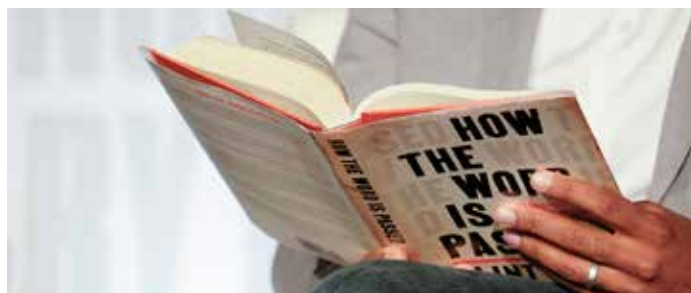

You will learn Hands-only CPR & AED; How to stop a major bleed; and Abdominal thrusts for choking with the Johnson County Ambulance Service Paramedics.

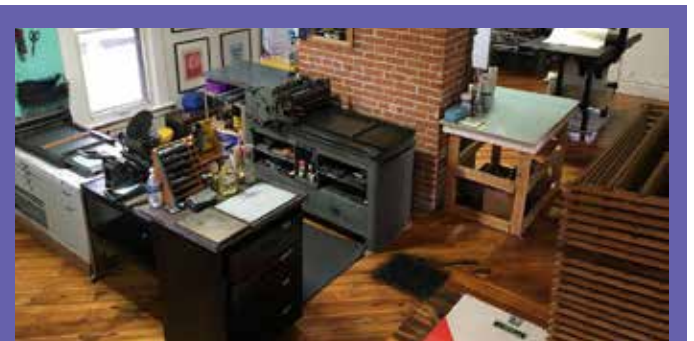
