#### BASIC CPR AND AED - WHAT TO DO AFTER YOU'VE CALLED 911

Hands-only CPR, use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and choking response can be learned in as little as 30 minutes. This short workshop, consisting of a video presentation followed by hands-on practice led by Paramedics from the Johnson County Ambulance Service can give you the basic lifesaving skills you need to make a difference in those first few minutes until emergency services arrive.

#### ASTRONOMY NIGHT AT THE PALISADES-DOWS OBSERVATORY

#### METEOR CRATERS OF IOWA

Dr. Ray Anderson, Adjunct Professor, will discuss what happened when a meteor more than one mile in diameter blasted through the atmosphere and left a 5-mile deep hole at what is today the town of Mason, about 50 miles northwest of Ames, and about 469 million years ago when fragments of a fractured asteroid crashed to Earth, one fragment in northeast Iowa at what is now Decorah. These impacts may have contributed to one of the largest mass extinction events on planet Earth!
