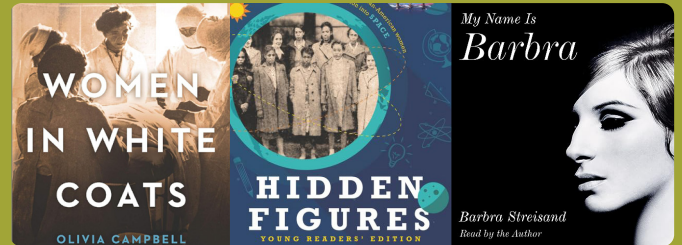


BEYOND 60 - A WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH FILM

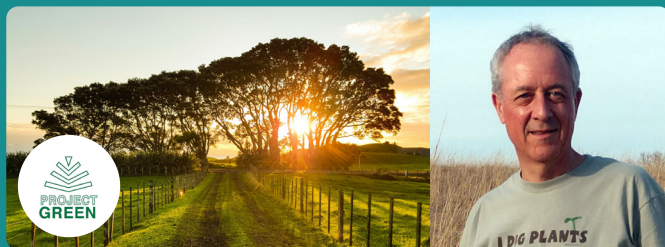
DEMOGRAPHIC FEARS AND THE HISTORY OF REPRODUCTION IN THE MIDWEST

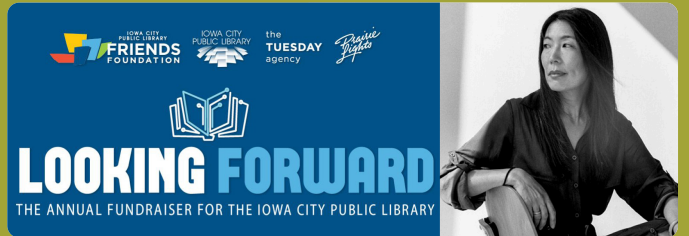

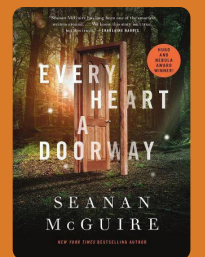
