VITA: VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE

Volunteers from the University of Iowa Tippie College Accounting Program and Law School, provide free income tax preparation help in the Library's meeting rooms. The VITA program is designed to provide free tax assistance at community locations to individuals who cannot afford professional tax help. Volunteers prepare tax returns and e-file the returns free of charge.

You must bring a copy of any tax returns that you filed during 2018 – generally this will be your 2017 tax return. You must also bring any pertinent interest and withholding statements, all other tax-related documents you received (1099-R, 1099-MISC, etc.), and all receipts to document deductions you claim.

You CANNOT use this service if you are:

- Single or married and your gross income exceeds \$55,000;
- Self-employed with inventory or expenses over \$10,000;
- Using your home for business and want to declare part of your home as a business expense;
- The owner of a working farm;
- In the military and had non-taxable combat pay.

BLACK HISTORY MONTH FILM: "I AM NOT YOUR NEGRO"

"I Am Not Your Negro", released in 2016, is an Oscar nominated documentary about race in modern America. In 1979, James Baldwin wrote a letter to his literary agent describing his next project, "Remember This House." The book was to be a revolutionary, personal account of the lives and assassinations of three of his close friends: Medgar Evers, Malcolm X and Martin Luther King, Jr. At the time of Baldwin's death in 1987, he left behind only 30 completed pages of this manuscript. Filmmaker Raoul Peck envisions the book James Baldwin never finished. 1:33 minutes.

MAKING LANDSCAPES WORK FOR WILDLIFE WITH ADAM JANKE

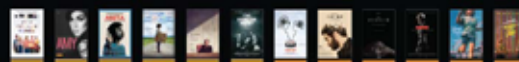
