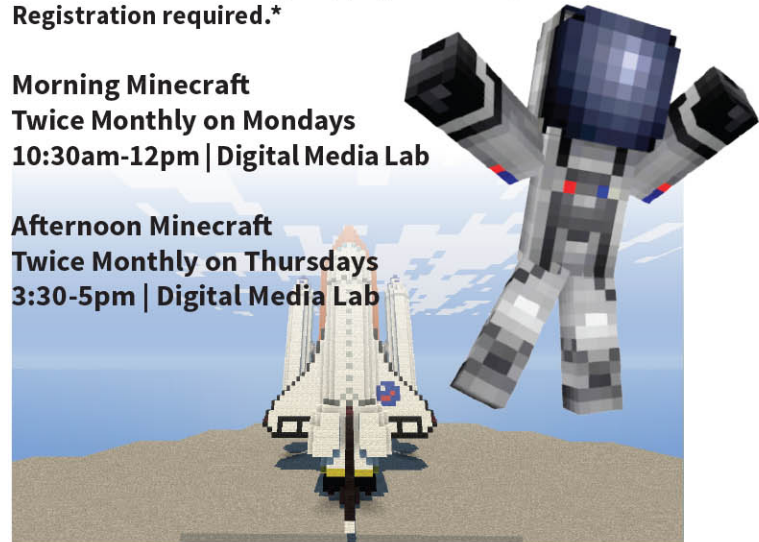

Champagne Academy of Irish Dance

Moroccan Tiles
July 3

Directly from the Land of Oz comes a natural born entertainer, Mikayla Oz! You will see things appear, vanish, teleport, transform

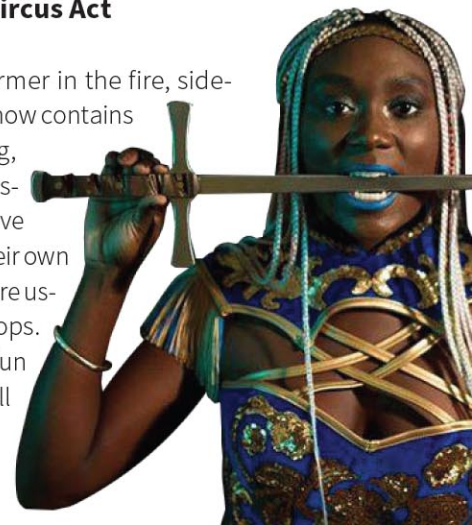


Outer Space Odyssey! July 18, 10:30 & 12:30

July 28: Straw Rockets

Create a tiny rocket that can shoot up in the air! But instead of jet fuel, it uses air from your lungs. You can challenge other rocket-makers to see whose can go the highest!

August 4: Galaxy in a Jar Sensory Bottles

Sometimes called "Calm Down" bottles, these galaxy-like sensory jars are a soothing toy you can make yourself. We will use baby oil, food color and glitter to recreate some of the visual qualities of space!
