

### Moroccan Tiles July 3

#### Mini Tres Leches Cakes July 10

This moist cake is one of the most traditional recipes of Latin America that includes three different types of milk: cream, evaporated milk, and sweetened condensed milk. We will make a simple mini-version of this cake to enjoy in a cup!

#### South Korean Ddakji game July 17

Ddakji, sometimes called ttakji, is a traditional South Korean game played using folded paper tiles. We will learn more about South Korea, create our own playing tiles and try out the game together!

#### Greek Mosaic Art July 24

A mosaic is a picture made up of thousands of small pieces of glass, pottery, or small tiles. Everyone will have the chance to create their own mosaics in the style of Greek mosaic tradition!

#### Mexican Pom Poms with Tassels July 31

The traditional clothing of the Huichol Nation is adorned with many colorful pom poms with tassels. Often a gesture of good luck, pom poms make a cute decoration for backpacks or just a burst of color for your room!

#### Swedish Dala Horses August 7

Dala horses (or Dalecarlian horses) are carved and painted wooden horses originating in the Swedish province of Dalarna. Originally made as toys for children, they are now a symbol of Sweden. We will learn more about the tradition of the Dala horse and create our own to take home!


